On behalf of the NSBA – Saskatoon's Business Association, I would like to extend our sincere congratulations on you, our members, in helping maintain a fair tax ratio for businesses in Saskatoon. We are pleased to share that City Council has officially rescinded its March 26, 2025, decision to adopt a commercial-to-residential property tax ratio of 1.88. Instead, Council has now approved a revised ratio of **1.71**, reaffirming the long-standing 68% to 32% property tax revenue split between residential and non-residential properties.

This outcome is a direct result of your engagement.

Your letters made it clear to Council that Saskatoon's business community values fairness, consistency, and a taxation approach that supports economic stability. By working together and speaking with a unified voice, we were able to help influence a more balanced decision that acknowledges the pressures facing businesses across our city.

Thank you for stepping up and showing what a strong, connected business community can achieve. We will continue working on your behalf to build a more competitive, sustainable business climate—and we look forward to tackling the next challenge together.
