Re: Update on Millar Avenue Transportation Projects

We at the NSBA – Saskatoon’s Business Association, want to inform you that both of the following items scheduled for consideration by the City of Saskatoon’s Standing Policy Committee on Transportation have now been **deferred** by the City:

- 51st Street and Millar Avenue Intersection Improvement
- Connecting Millar Avenue from 43rd Street to Marquis Drive – Active Transportation Improvements

Your feedback played an important role in ensuring decision-makers at the City understood the real-world implications these proposals could have on business access, trucking and deliveries, employee and customer mobility, and overall traffic flow in this critical employment and industrial area.

The NSBA will continue to closely monitor these projects as they evolve. We remain committed to advocating for solutions that improve safety and transportation efficiency without compromising the ability of businesses to operate, grow, and remain accessible.

Should these items return to committee or Council, we will again work to ensure your voices are heard early and clearly.
